The Adult Sunday school curriculum on this CD is intended to assist in identifying candidates for the Leadership Center initiative adopted by the North American Baptist Conference and rolled out locally in your Association.

The purpose for creating this curriculum began with the belief that God was moving in the hearts of many who sit in the pews on Sunday morning, but pastors and other ministry staff were not always aware of His already present action in many of His disciples.

In an attempt to permit the Holy Spirit to draw people into a spiritual formation opportunity that the Leadership Center represents, this curriculum was created to introduce some of the elements of the Emerging Phase.

Those elements include:

- Expository study (Jeremiah)
- Word study (heart)
- Journaling
- Sharing of personal insight during class time
- Mentoring (an opportunity to share insights in a one-on-one meeting with you.
